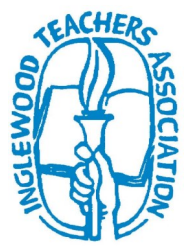

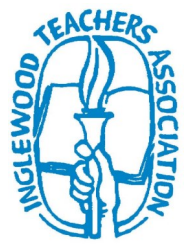
Greetings ITA Members,

Your ITA Bargaining Team has met with the district's bargaining team for continued negotiations of the 2020-2021 COVID-19 school reopening. The two sides have been in discussions in the following areas and will continue to meet to address:

- ⇒ Re-evaluate and redefine agendas and ground rules for respectful and timely negotiations
- ⇒ Adhering to the safety guidelines in the "Reopening Protocols for K-12 Schools" by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health regarding schools reopening at 100% distance learning during the COVID-19 pandemic
- ⇒ Allocation and spending of \$16.2 million in CARES Act funds received by the district
- ⇒ Consultation on teaching and learning as related to the hybrid model
- ⇒ Protocols, work conditions, and safety implications of in-person testing for specialized and targeted student assessments
- ⇒ Stipends and/or reimbursements for technology during distance learning
- ⇒ Adjunct duties and other paid extra duty assignments
- ⇒ Evaluations
- ⇒ Leave of absence
- ⇒ On-going training for staff as it relates to COVID-19 protocols by LACDPH
